Each Retro A1 12.7" carbine barrel assembly includes a front-sight base, .625", no F marks, complete with sight post, detent, spring, sling swivel, rivet, flat Delta ring, barrel nut, weld spring, snap ring, and round handguard cap installed. Machined from 4150 chrome moly steel. The barrel you need for your next Retro Rifle build!

Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 12.7" A1 Carbine Barrel Assembly
