Safety Instruction Guide for Brownells 6.5 Grendel AR15 Barrel

Introduction

5. Carefully thread the Brownells 6.5 Grendel barrel into the receiver, ensuring it is aligned properly.

7. Install the gas block and gas tube according to the manufacturer's instructions.
