This Lower Receiver is made from billet 7075 T-6 aluminum with a hard-anodized finish, has integral oversized trigger guard, and the unique features of a threaded bolt catch pin and captive set screw for the takedown pin detent spring, both included. Due to the proprietary design nature of the BRN-180M® Lower Receiver it will not function with standard AR-15 upper receivers.
