

BROWNING T-BOLT PICATINNY SCOPE MOUNT - EGW BROWNING T-BOLT 1-PIECE PICATINNY BASE 0 MOA

This mount comes standard with a bevel on both sides making it ambidextrous. EGW recommends measuring the hole spacing in your receiver to confirm it matches with the dimensions they have published. Picatinny cross slots run the full length of the rail, which gives the shooter flexibility when mounting scope rings and other accessories. The channel in the center reduces the overall mass of the mount. Also, in many cases, it will not obstruct usage of factory iron sights. Their one-piece scope mounts are the obvious choice for hunters and tactical shooters alike. They machine these in their shop using one of their machining centers. After machining, the mounts are tumbled, sand blasted, and Type II anodized for long lasting durability.

Installation: EGW recommends 20 inch lbs of torque and a drip of blue loctite (loctite is sold separately). They recommend: 0 MOA - if shooting 0-500 yards 20 MOA - if shooting 500-1000 yards When zeroing your rifle with a 20 MOA mount, they recommend zeroing at 200 yards. The entire mount and accessories (from the mounting screws and wrench down to the packaging) are made in the USA.

- Confirm that the hole spacing in your receiver matches the dimensions published by EGW.
- Position the scope mount on the receiver, aligning the holes.
- Insert the mounting screws into the holes and handtighten them.
- Using a torque wrench, tighten the screws to a recommended torque of 20 inch lbs.
- Apply a drip of blue Loctite to each screw for added security (Loctite sold separately).

3. Usage:

- When zeroing your rifle with a 20 MOA mount, it is recommended to zero at 200 yards.
- Adjust the scope rings and accessories as needed, utilizing the full length of the Picatinny cross slots for flexibility.

4. PostInstallation Check:

- After installation, doublecheck all screws for tightness.
- Ensure that the mount does not obstruct the usage of factory iron sights.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product and packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of electronic components in regular household waste.
- Consider recycling materials wherever possible to minimize environmental impact.
