# L5AWM GEN 2 5.56x45 NATO RIFLE MAGAZINE SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the L5AWM GEN 2 5.56x45 NATO Rifle Magazine by Lancer Systems. This product is designed to provide reliable performance and durability for various applications, including military, law enforcement, and competition. To ensure safe usage and compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR), please read and follow these safety instructions carefully.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the magazine is used only with compatible firearms. The L5AWM is designed for use with M4/M16/AR15, SCAR16, HK416, ARX160, SIG556, ARC, SIG MCX, IWI Tavor, IWI X95, and SA80 firearms chambered in 5.56x45mm / .223 Remington.
- Always handle the magazine with care. Treat it as if it is loaded, even when it is empty.
- Keep the magazine out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Regularly inspect the magazine for any signs of damage or wear. Do not use if damaged.
- Store the magazine in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- Before loading the magazine, ensure that the firearm is pointed in a safe direction and that the safety is engaged.
- Load the magazine only with 5.56 mm NATO cartridges. Using incorrect ammunition may result in malfunction or injury.
- Avoid overloading the magazine beyond its 30round capacity.
