Insert battery (or batteries) with the positive (+) terminal towards the foam at the bottom. Close the tube and latch, making sure no material is caught in the tube/cap interface.

- Unfold the latch to a 90degree angle to secure it in place.

3. Insert Batteries:

- Verify that the foam shock absorber is at the bottom of the CELLVAULT 18 tube.
- Insert one 18650 battery or two 18350 batteries with the positive (+) terminal facing the foam.
- Ensure that the batteries fit snugly and securely.

4. Close and Secure:

- Close the tube and latch, ensuring no material is caught in the tube/cap interface.
- Make sure the latch is fully engaged to prevent accidental opening.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the CELLVAULT 18 according to local regulations for electronic waste.
- Batteries should be disposed of at designated battery recycling locations. Do not throw batteries in

regular trash.
