Safety Instruction Guide for DELUXE 3DIE SETS

300 WEATHERBY MAGNUM 3 DIE SET

Introduction

- Inspect each round for proper fit and function before proceeding to load them into firearms.

3. **PostUse Care**

- After using the die set, clean the dies with a soft cloth to remove any residue.
- Store the die set in its original box, along with the spare decapping pin and hex wrench, to prevent damage.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or worn dies according to local waste management regulations.
- Unused or expired reloading components should be disposed of in a safe manner, following local regulations for hazardous materials.
