MDT LSS Gen 2 Chassis System Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the MDT LSS Gen 2 Chassis System designed for the Savage Axis SA RH FDE rifle. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure safe and effective use of your chassis system.
