

Dillon Debris-Out Casefeeder Adapter - Dillon Debris-Out Casefeeder Adapter (.40 S&W)

This is an essential upgrade, as blockages inside the adapter tube can cause quite a few malfunctions. Small pieces of corn cob media often remain mixed with the brass and are carried down through the case feed tube. When they reach the narrower diameter of the adapter tube, they jam against the cases and cause a feeding malfunction. The Debris-Out Casefeeder Adapter replaces the original Dillon casefeeder adapter on your XL650 / XL750. Slots cut into the tube allow debris to fall out sideways into a small catch tray, significantly reducing the likelihood of jams.
